This letter is a response to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff request for the US Army Installation Management Command (IMCOM) to provide its plans or schedules for submitting its license amendment application for license SUC-1593. The request is dated November 12, 2014, Subject: Programmatic Approach to Amend Source Material License SUC-1593 to Add the Remaining U.S. Army Installations Possessing Depleted Uranium from the Davy Crockett Weapons System (Docket Number 040-09083).

In response to this request, IMCOM has developed and is pursuing a schedule for submitting the final license amendment application to the NRC on or before April 17, 2015.
