SUBJECT: SCION INSTRUMENTS (FORMERLY BRUKER DALTONICS) EXEMPT
DISTRIBUTION LICENSE APPLICATION FEE DUE

Dear Mr. Tu:

This letter is in reference to Scion Instruments' (formerly Bruker Daltonics) U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) exempt-distribution license. On July 29, 2013, Bruker Daltonics (now Scion Instruments) submitted an application for a new exempt-distribution license, and on July 21, 2014, the NRC issued the license (license no. 04-35093-01E).

In accordance with 10 CFR 170.31, licenses issued under subpart A of 10 CFR 32 to distribute items containing byproduct material or quantities of byproduct material that do not require device evaluation to persons exempt from the licensing requirements of 10 CFR Part 30, are required to pay an application fee of \$11,200.00. To date, Scion Instruments has not paid the total application fee. On October 7, 2014, the NRC received a partial payment from Scion Instruments in the amount of \$4,300.00. Attached is NRC Form 577, "Licensee fee requirements," with the additional amount due.

If Scion Instruments does not pay this debt within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, then the exempt-distribution license will be revoked by NRC, and Scion Instruments will not be able to operate under license no. 04-35093-01E. If Scion Instruments wants to resume operations after NRC revocation of the license, then Scion will have to pay all debts to NRC and apply for a new license (this would further require payment of a new application fee).

The payment must be submitted to NRC along with NRC Form 577. This form provides the address to submit the payment. In addition, attached is NRC Form 629 in case Scion Instruments prefers to pay via credit card instead of check. Even if Scion Instruments chooses to pay by credit card, the payment must still accompany NRC Form 577.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in NRC's Public Document room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS).
