Dear Mr. Amey:

On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to your letter dated November 24, 2014. You appealed the agency's October 28, 2014, decision to deny the release of information in your Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act (FOIA/PA) request that the NRC received on October 3, 2014 (FOIA/PA-2015-0007).

Acting on your appeal, I have reviewed the one responsive record in this case and have determined that the agency will make a discretionary release of the previously withheld document, "U.S. NRC Travel Charge Card Management Plan," dated January 31, 2014 (Item 1 of your request).

In the NRC's final response dated October 28, 2014, the agency did not address the remaining items in your FOIA request. The explanations for those items are as follows:

1. FOIA Request Item 1: The Charge Card Management Plans from each executive agency required to be submitted to OMB by January 31, 2014.

NRC Response: As stated above.

2. FOIA Request Item 2: Semi-Annual Joint Purchase and Integrated Card Violation Reports from each executive agency required to be submitted to the OMB by January 31, 2014.

NRC Response: The above named report is not applicable to the NRC because the agency does not spend more than \$10 million in a fiscal year on purchase cards. Beginning in FY13, each agency with more than \$10 million in purchase card spending during the prior fiscal year had to submit semiannual reports.

3. FOIA Request Item 3: The Semi-Annual Joint Purchase and Integrated Card Violation Reports and related documents providing summary descriptions of confirmed violations involving the misuse of a purchase card or integrated card.

NRC Response: The above report does not apply to the NRC because the agency does not spend more than \$10 million in a fiscal year on purchase cards.

4. FOIA Request: The Semi-Annual Joint Purchase and Integrated Card Violation Reports and related documents providing descriptions of all adverse personnel actions, punishments, or other actions taken in response to each reportable violation involving misuse of a purchase or integrated card.

NRC Response: The above report does not apply to the NRC because the agency does not spend more than \$10 million in a fiscal year on purchase cards.

After an extensive search of agency records, the NRC staff located only one responsive document.
