SUMMARY

By the application dated November 20, 2014 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession Number No. ML14338A843), AREVA Federal Services LLC (certificate holder) requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9341 for the Model No. BEA Research Reactor (BRR) Package. The certificate holder did not request any changes to the package design or the safety analysis report. The certificate has been renewed for an additional five year term expiring on January 31, 2020.

EVALUATION

By the letter dated November 20, 2014, AREVA Federal Services LLC requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9341, for the Model No. BEA Research Reactor (BRR) Package. AREVA Federal Services LLC did not request any changes to the package design, authorized contents, operating procedures, acceptance tests, or maintenance program of the package.

The staff reviewed the documents referenced in the certificate and determined that the documentation was available and complete. The staff also reviewed the operating and maintenance procedures for the package and found them to be adequate.

The following changes have been made to the certificate:

Condition No. 9 was modified to change the expiration date to January 31, 2020.

CONCLUSION

The certificate has been renewed for a five year term. These changes do not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
