Dear Mr. Hernly:

This letter responds to your correspondence to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on December 6, 2014, as supplemented on January 6, 2015, (Accession Nos. ML15015A149 and ML15015A057 in the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System). In your correspondence, you requested that the NRC amend Part 26 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) by making various changes to the regulations related to fatigue management programs.

We have carefully reviewed your request and have concluded that the information provided in your correspondence does not meet the Commission's criteria for a petition for rulemaking under 10 CFR 2.802(c) (see <http://www.gpo.gov/fdsys/granule/CFR-2014-title10-vol1/CFR-2014-title10-vol1-sec2-802>). As required by 10 CFR 2.802(c)(3), your request must include relevant technical, scientific or other data involved which is reasonably available to you, and other pertinent information as you deem necessary to support the action sought. Your request does not meet this requirement. Also, you do not state clearly if you submitted this petition on behalf of the security officers at the Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station, the United Security Professionals of America Local #8, or yourself.

If you want the NRC to consider your request to amend its regulations, you must supplement your correspondence of December 6, 2014, as supplemented on January 6, 2015, as well as state clearly whether you are submitting the petition for yourself or on behalf of another party. This information must be received by the NRC within 90 days of the date of this letter or your request will not be considered further for docketing as a petition for rulemaking.
