On December 31, 2014, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff completed its annual inspection of the Emergency Preparedness Program at the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant. This inspection began on January 1, 2014. Issuance of this letter closes Inspection Report Number 2014501. Inspection activities charged to these reports include conducting midcycle/end of cycle assessment activities, responding to technical questions from resident inspectors or licensee personnel, and in some cases, performing traditional enforcement activities.
