This letter is in reference to your application dated October 22, 2014, requesting a U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) license, and a teleconference on January 22, 2015, between members of your staff and NRC.

A preliminary review of the licensed activities requested in your October 22, 2014, application was conducted. Based on this review and our telephone conversation, it was determined that the requested activities in your license application dated October 22, 2014, were comparable with your previously submitted application dated August 29, 2014, for a NRC license and should be combined as one license action. Therefore, as discussed, your license application dated October 22, 2014, has been voided and combined with your license application dated August 29, 2014. Please note that all future correspondence regarding your combined requests should be referenced under NRC Control No. 584728.
