## Semiannual Report, Second Half 2014 (July 1 through December 31, 2014)


No development or construction activities have been undertaken at the Ross Project site since issuance of SUA-1601. There have been no drilling activities. Due to the lack of activities at the site that would result in disturbances or the production or release of source or byproduct material no effluent and environmental monitoring was conducted during the reporting period.

The only monitoring activity governed by SUA-1601 during the period was the continued operation of a Meteorological Station as required under License Condition 12.13. On May 1, 2014 Strata submitted additional meteorological data analysis and a license amendment request to remove License Condition 12.13. NRC has not taken action on this amendment request. Therefore the meteorological station has remained in operation throughout the reporting period.

Strata did not construct any wells and did not perform any mechanical integrity tests during the reporting period.

Strata will implement the environmental monitoring program required under SUA-1601 when major construction activities commence at the Ross site. Strata projects that this monitoring will begin in the first quarter of 2015 due to the planned commencement of construction at the Ross site.

Strata will submit quarterly reports as required under License Condition 11.1 (A) and (B) when operations (lixiviant injection) commence at the site. This is currently projected to begin in the third quarter of 2015.



## Annual Report - 2014 (April 24 through December 31, 2014)

License Condition 11.1(E):

Strata did not conduct any SERP evaluations during the reporting

period.

License Condition 11.1(F):

Water Supply Wells: The only change to the inventory of nearby water supply wells since submittal of the Ross application is the issuance of a groundwater appropriation by the Wyoming State Engineer's Office (SEO) for the Ross PWS Well No. 1 (P201597W). This is the planned Public Water Supply well for the Ross CPP. This well has not been constructed at this time.

Land Use Survey: There are no production areas at the Ross site so a land use survey was not conducted for this annual report.
