SUMMARY AND ACTION REQUIRED (IF ANY)
 The purpose of this telephone call was to discuss the licensee's letter notifying the NRC of a change in the name of the licensee.

I e-mailed an attachment to Tom from NUREG-1556, volume 9, revision 2. It lists the information that licensees need to address when there is a transfer of control of a license. Per NRC regulations, a transfer of control of an NRC license is **not** to take place until the NRC gives its consent in writing.

Per the discussion that Tom and I had today, it's my understanding that the change in the name is reflective in a change in control of the license, however, there were no changes in the radiation safety program of staff (e.g., the RSO), facilities, equipment,, etc., that would have impacted the radiation safety program.

Therefore, I plan to issue a partial amendment to authorize the filter change out frequency described in their November 11 letter. In my cover letter, I will state our understanding that the licensee will follow-up with another amendment request ASAP regarding the name change and include a response to each of the six items listed in the attachment.
