Enclosed please find Table A.3.6, which was inadvertently omitted from the 1/12/15 submission.

Please note that the labor rates in Table A.3.12 are correct. In 2013, the labor rates were based on the labor cost for expedited decommissioning of the Gerontology Research Center. The labor rates in the 2014 Table A.3.12 are based on the labor cost from a mix of expedited and non-expedited projects that occurred in 2014. Thus, the minimal impact of the cost-of-living increase from 2013 to 2014 was offset by the decrease in labor cost for the non-expedited projects.
