Dear Dr. Ege:

You have been appointed the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) of this facility for our United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission Materials License. This "Letter of Understanding" is prepared to comply with Title 10 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 35.24(b). This section of the regulations requires that you agree in writing to the following:

- > Assume responsibility for implementing the Radiation Protection Program
- > Ensure that radiation safety activities are being performed in accordance with our own approved procedures and all regulatory requirements.

Furthermore, in compliance with 10 CFR 35.24(e), (g), the executive management of this facility agrees to provide you as RSO:

- > Specific written notation of your authority, duties, and responsibilities, see attached.
- > Sufficient authority, organization freedom, time, resources, and management prerogative to:
 1. Identify radiation safety problems;
 2. Initiate, recommend, or provide corrective actions;
 3. Stop unsafe operations; and,
 4. Verify implementation of corrective actions.

Dear Ms. Partlo:

Enclosed is the draft letter for the license amendment that replaces the RSO. The following steps need to be taken to insure proper handling by the NRC.

1. Review all information for correctness. Check addresses, names, and license numbers, **specifically**.
2. Have the letter to the NRC typed or photocopied onto your facility letterhead.
3. Have executive administration (V.P. or higher) sign the letter.
4. Have the RSO/ Executive Management Letter of Understanding typed or photocopied onto facility letterhead. Have the name of executive management typed above executive management title. Have this agreement signed by both executive management and Dr. Ege. A copy of this signed letter should be filed in the MPC license binder in the nuclear medicine department.
5. **Make a copy of these documents.** Send the original to the NRC. Keep the copy and file in the blue MPC binder under NRC correspondence in the nuclear medicine department.
6. Mail the letter to the NRC, with the Letter of Understanding. Fed - EX or U.P.S. mail is advised.


