Dear Mr. Adams,

Is there anyway to remove: "The contents of this page are proprietary to Tetra Tech."
If not, please follow 10 CFR 2.390 to withhold from the public. We will need an affidavit and a public version.

OR

Resend but replace the resume with a shortened version identifying the person's name as you want it to appear on the license, what radionuclides you have worked with (should be similar to the nuclides listed on the license) and what training you have given or taken. Do not provide education or your resume.

Please note that we do not need PII (e.g., where you went to school, the places you have worked, etc.).

1. What is and what is not PII?

PII is information that can be used to identify or contact a person uniquely and reliably or can be traced back to a specific individual. That is, PII is a person's name, in combination with any of the following information: relatives' names, postal address, email address, home or cellular telephone number, personal characteristics, Social Security number, date or place of birth, mother's maiden name, driver's license number, bank account information, credit card information, or other information that would make the individual's personal identity easily traceable. Note that personal identity is distinct from an individual's professional identity; that is, an employee's name, title, work telephone number, official work location, and work email address are not considered to be PII.

PII is not information related to the workplace such as the work address, work phone number or work email address. Additionally, the Office of General Counsel has advised that it is not necessary to remove home addresses, home phone numbers, or home email addresses from adjudicatory filings, documents associated with agency rulemakings, and correspondence received from the public on regulatory matters.

In terms of licensing guidance please follow NUREG-1556 Volume 18:

Based on NUREG-1556, Volume 18, Section 8.7.1, for a change of RSO – we need:

The name of the proposed RSO who will be responsible for ensuring that the licensee's radiation safety program is implemented in accordance with approved procedures.

AND

" Demonstrate that the RSO has sufficient independence and direct communication with responsible management officials by providing a copy of an organizational chart by position, demonstrating day-to-day oversight of the radiation safety activities.

AND EITHER

*** The specific training and experience of the RSO. ** Include the specific dates of training in radiation safety.*

OR

" Alternative information demonstrating that the proposed RSO is qualified by training and experience (e.g., Board Certification by the American Board of Health Physicists, completion of a bachelor's and/or master's degree in the sciences with at least one year of experience in the conduct of a radiation safety program of comparable size and scope).

Also the signed NRC Form 313 attached to your email has an address of San Diego, CA listed. Please note that our licenses are coded by state. For example a license that begins with 29 is for New Jersey. So this address change will require termination of your 29 license and an issuance of a new license. In addition, California is located in the NRC's Region IV territory and thus will be transferred to them. In your response, please confirm the mailing address for the Tetra Tech EC decommissioning service provider license.
