Enclosed is an application (XSNM3672/03), dated January 23, 2015, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from the U.S. Department of Energy's Y-12 National Security Complex (DOE/NNSA/Y-12), requesting amendment No. 3 to its export license XSNM3672/02. The license presently authorizes the export of 237.3 kilograms uranium-235 contained in 1189.5 kilograms uranium, enriched to 19.95 weight % maximum, to Canada for reload fuel for National Research Universal Reactor.

The purpose of this amendment is to change the company name of the intermediate and ultimate consignee from Atomic Energy of Canada Limited (AECL) to Canadian Nuclear Laboratories (CNL) and add DOE/NNSA/Y-12 to the list of "Other U.S. Part(ies) to Export" as supplier/transporter. There are no changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license being requested; therefore, our office is processing this as a minor amendment. The NRC intends to issue the license after the required 30-day review period.
