Subject: Status of petition for rulemaking submitted to the NRC

Mr. Slodowitz:

I am writing in regard to your December 2, 2011, letter in which you submitted a petition for rulemaking to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) (available in the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) under Accession No. ML12132A332). You submitted supplemental information on September 18, 2012 (ADAMS Accession No. ML13112B010). You request that the NRC amend its requirements in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 30.15, 10 CFR 30.19(c), and 10 CFR 32.22(b) to include illumination markers containing tritium.

The petition was assigned Docket No. NRC-2013-0078, and a notice of receipt and request for public comment were published in the *Federal Register* on July 11, 2013 (78 FR 41720). The public comment period ended on September 24, 2013. The NRC received one public comment. The comment has been posted at www.regulations.gov (Docket ID: NRC-2013-0078).

The NRC staff is considering the merits of your petition and the public comment received. Once the NRC makes a decision on the petition, a notice will be published in the *Federal Register* explaining the Commission's finding. You will also receive a letter at that time notifying you of the action that the Commission has taken.
