Dear Public Affairs officer,

I am an Investigator with the law firm of Labaton Sucharow LLP. I am conducting a research project and request your assistance. In April of 2013 the NRC sent a notice of violation and proposed a civil penalty of \$36,400 against Chicago Bridge & Iron (CB&I) for discrimination by one of its newly purchased Shaw subsidiaries against an employee who raised a safety concern. The NRC also requested CB&I take action to improve safety culture at a second former Shaw subsidiary.
