SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF FEBRUARY 5, 2015 PUBLIC MEETING BETWEEN  
THE NRC AND INDUSTRY TO DISCUSS THE DRAFT WHITE  
PAPER PREPARED BY THE NUCLEAR ENERGY INSTITUTE  
TREATMENT OF UNCERTAINTY IN RISK-INFORMED  
DECISIONMAKING WORKING GROUP

On February 5, 2015, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 2 public meeting teleconference with the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) Treatment of Uncertainty in Risk-Informed Decisionmaking Working Group (WG). The purpose of this meeting was to provide NRC WG feedback on the draft white paper prepared by NEI on the Treatment of Uncertainty in Risk-Informed Decisionmaking, Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession Number ML15021A134.

Sunil Weerakkody of the U.S. NRC led the meeting and summarized previous activities between the working groups. He discussed the substantive comments included in the NRC's WG feedback email (ADAMS Accession Number ML15035A078) and edited draft NEI white paper (ADAMS Accession Number ML15035A057). Each of the participating NRC WG members were given an opportunity to discuss their edits and comments of the draft white paper. Fernando Ferrante of the U.S. NRC discussed additional NRC WG comments that were included in email (ADAMS Accession Number ML15040A128) sent to NEI following the public meeting. Members of the NEI WG were given an opportunity to provide feedback to NRC WG on the edited draft white paper. No additional clarification was requested.

The next steps for the WGs were discussed. The NRC WG requested NEI provide a feasible timeline for submitting a revised white paper for NRC review. The NRC WG suggested a milestone of February 28, 2015, to support briefing the Risk-Informed Steering Committees at their next public meeting. NEI stated they will provide a feasible milestone after internal discussions with their staff.

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The meeting was attended by 15 individuals, primarily representing industry, non-governmental organizations, and NRC staff and management. One member of the public attended and commented at the end of the meeting. No feedback forms were received after the meeting.
