Dear Mr. Munns:

This refers to your license amendment request to change the Radiation Safety Officer listed on your license. Enclosed with this letter is the amended license approving your request.

Please note that on December 17, 2013, the NRC converted your license to a storage only license. In accordance with 10 CFR Part 30.36, we expect decommissioning of the facility to be completed within 24 months (i.e., December 17, 2015) because a decommissioning plan was not submitted within 12 months and an alternate schedule has not been approved. In accordance with the conditions of your license, a decommissioning plan is not required unless decommissioning activities are required which are not currently authorized by your license. Current NRC guidance for decommissioning is in NUREG-1757, "Consolidated NMSS Decommissioning Guidance", Volumes 1, 2 and 3. In particular, you should review NUREG-1757, Volume 2, Appendix B, "Simple Approaches for Conducting Final Radiological Surveys." This guidance is available electronically at the NRC web site and can be reached directly at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1757/> License Condition 23 was added to your storage only license reminding you to keep the NRC notified as to the disposition of your radioactive material. This is a standard license condition for all storage only licenses.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
