Dear Mr. Schrauder:

By letter dated February 10, 2015 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML15043A037), Toshiba Corporation submitted an affidavit executed by yourself on February 10, 2015, requesting that the information contained in the following document be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Part 2, Section 2.390:

Enclosure 2 – “Proprietary Handouts Used at January 28, 2015 Meeting.”

Because of the extensive amount of proprietary information, a nonproprietary version of the slides was not provided.

The reasons for requesting withholding of the handouts are provided in the affidavit.

We have reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 and, on the basis of the statements in the affidavit, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Therefore, the submitted information marked as proprietary will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents. If the need arises, we may send copies of this information to our consultants working in this area. We will, of course, ensure that the consultants have signed the appropriate agreements for handling proprietary information.
