SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION OF OVERSIGHT INSPECTION AT NUSCALE POWER™, LLC

Dear Mr. Bergman:

On March 25, 2015, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) will perform an oversight inspection of your Safeguards Information (SGI) Protection Program in accordance with NRC Inspection Procedure (IP) 71130.06 "Protection of Safeguards Information." In order to minimize the impact to your onsite resources and to ensure a productive inspection, we request that you make the following documents available for review upon arrival of the Inspectors:

1. NP-QP-0602-211;
2. Criminal history records, used for making the trustworthiness and reliability determination, for employees/contractors that have been granted access to SGI;
3. SGI Authorization Requests;
4. SGI Transmittal Logs;
5. SGI Control Program Violation Reports;
6. SGI Control Program Audit and Surveillance Reports.

The inspection staff will appreciate if all of the requested documents are up to date and complete. We have found that such preparatory work minimizes the number of additional documents requested during the actual onsite portion of the inspection.

The objective of the oversight inspection is to identify, document and evaluate the procedural strengths and weaknesses of the NuScale Power, LLC information protection system for SGI. The inspection will be conducted by a two person team from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission from the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response. They would like to arrive at your Corvallis office at 8:30 am on Wednesday March 25, 2015, and commence the inspection with your Reviewing Official. If you would like a briefing before the start of the inspection please let the team know upon arrival.
