General Comment

My name is Cecilia Tusinski, and I live in the Town of Leyden which is fully within the 10-mile emergency zone of Vermont Yankee nuclear power plant. I am absolutely in opposition to the NRC granting Vermont Yankee, Entergy Inc. an exemption which would allow the end of funding for the 10 mile radius emergency planning zone (EPZ). I am also strongly suggesting that the NRC deny Energy Inc. an exemption which would delay the present 15 minute notification time to 60 minutes (1 hour). By the time one hour had passed, if there had been a major incident or leak, myself and my family and animals would have possibly already been exposed to radiation, depending upon the weather, prevailing winds, etc. An hour is simply unacceptable. I support the State of Vermont's efforts to require Entergy Inc., the owner of Vermont Yankee, to continue EPZ emergency planning zone coverage for the present 10 mile radius around Vermont Yankee and continue funding the EPZ until the spent fuel pool is empty and all high radioactive spent fuel is in dry cask storage.
