To whom it may concern, my wife Debbie and I strongly oppose Entergy Corporation's application for an exemption that will allow it to end funding

for the EPZ. The EPZ has in place a protective action plan designed to avoid/reduce potential exposure to radioactive materials, by including sheltering, evacuation and the use of potassium iodide when appropriate. Entergy has also asked for an exemption allowing a delay in the notification

time for warnings to 60 minutes from the present 15 minutes.
