The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission is publishing the following document in the *Federal Register*:

- Title: Mitigation of Beyond-Design-Basis Events [RIN 3150-AJ49; NRC-2014-0240]
- Description of the document: this document proposes to amend Parts 50 and 52 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*: “Domestic licensing of production and utilization facilities,” and “Licenses, certifications, and approvals for nuclear power plants.”
- The Nuclear Regulatory Commission is conducting this rulemaking primarily to amend the regulations to reflect the requirements imposed on current licensees by orders for mitigation of beyond-design-basis events (EA-12-049), and for reliable spent fuel pool instrumentation (EA-12-051).
- Dates: The public comment period will be open for 75 days after this document is published.
