Subject: Bankruptcy Details

Discussion: Region I received notification from the licensee that it filed for bankruptcy under Chapter 11 of US Bankruptcy Code. I called the licensee to obtain information about any effects that the filing may have on its licensed activities, what material they possessed, and why the notification was not immediate as required by 10 CFR 30.34(h)(1).

The licensee stated that the bankruptcy filing did not affect any of their licensed activities and they continue to operate normally. They possessed 6 moisture/density gauges and they continue to maintain possession of the gauges that are securely stored at the storage location specified on the license. He continues to remain the Radiation Safety Officer. With regard to delayed notification, he stated that it fell through cracks and the lawyer did not identify the notification requirement. He identified the requirement when he was performing audit of the program. I reminded him of the licensee's responsibilities and obligations under the license and that they need to notify NRC if there is a change in their licensed activities.
