Dear Mr. Lawyer:

This letter is in response to the additional information requested for the change of name and ownership pertaining to the DuPont Edge Moor site. The change is to occur in the following manner:

As of February 1, 2015, the DuPont Edge Moor site will be operated by The Chemours Company, F.C., L.L.C. which will be a wholly owned subsidiary of the E. I. du Pont de Nemours and Company. As, of July 1, 2015, The Chemours Company, F.C., L.L.C. will be an entity distinct from the E. I. du Pont de Nemours and Company and will be the owner and operator of the DuPont Edge Moor plant. The DuPont Edge Moor plant will be referred to as the Chemours Edge Moor plant.

The corporate reorganization will create, after separation, world-leading businesses in Titanium Technologies and Chemicals & Fluoroproducts, with well-established positions in attractive markets, and strong cash flow generation. The Performance Chemicals segment, from which Chemours will arise, employs approximately 9,000 people and, in 2013, generated about \$7 billion in revenue. DuPont expects that upon launch it will take its place as a new "Fortune 500" company.

There will be no change of responsibility at the site level, Elizabeth Schowe will remain the Site Manager and Gary Brown will remain the RSO for Edge Moor. The Chemours Company will continue to comply with all requirements of NRC License #07-00455-29.

Based on prior conversations with Mr. Lawyer, I am submitting the name change request and Form 313. I will submit a new license request the week of February 16th for our March 31, 2015 license renewal deadline.



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
