The Environmental Administrator of the Radiation Materials Section became vacant on 2/2/15. The position advertisement closed on 2/13/15 and applications are under review.

Environmental Specialist II – Orange Park Inspector became vacant 8/8/14. Position has been advertised three times. Applicants had very little, if any, radiation experience. Offered to one individual and was declined due to salary. Readvertised with a closing date of 1/9/15. Position was placed on hold by the department.

Florida uses a fifteen member advisory council to provide recommendations to the program. The Advisory Council on Radiation Protection is made up of the following disciplines: board certified chiropractic radiologist, board certified podiatrist, board certified radiological physicist, board certified therapeutic radiologist or board certified radiation oncologist, two lay persons who have no radiological background, certified radiologic technologist-radiographer, certified radiologic technologist-nuclear medicine, certified radiologic technologist-therapy, basic x-ray machine operator or licensed practitioner who employs same, certified health physicist, expert in environmental matters, representative from the administration of a hospital affiliated with a radiologic technology education program, board certified radiologist, and a board certified nuclear medicine physician. Since this is an advisory council and can only make recommendations there is no conflict of interest.

17. Describe or provide an update on your instrumentation, methods of calibration, and laboratory capabilities. Are all instruments properly calibrated at the present time? Were there sufficient calibrated instruments available throughout the review period?

Florida has continued to receive Department of Homeland Security grant funding over the past three years and has purchased emergency response equipment and radiation detection instruments for the area offices.

Each inspector currently has:

Thermo Rad Eye PRD Alarming Personal Radiation Detector
Ludlum Model 2401-P beta gamma pancake
Canberra Model 213 Ultra/Mini-Radiac
Thermo EPD Mark 2 electronic personnel dosimeter

In addition, each inspector has access to a zinc sulfide alpha scintillator rate meter, a Far West Technology REM 500B neutron rate meter, and a radioisotope identifier, primarily a Flir/IcX Identifinder, and in three offices a Canberra Inspector 1000.

The Miami area has access to a high resolution Ortec Detective EX RIID, and the Tallahassee and Orlando areas have access to a high resolution Ortec Detective EX-100 RIID, with one in the Tallahassee HQ and two in the Orlando Lab.

All equipment is calibrated at the radiation/electronic calibration lab in Orlando, Florida. NIST traceability is accomplished through the use of pressurized ion chambers calibrated biennially by a NIST traceable vendor.

We are on schedule for all instrument calibrations and have maintained adequate numbers of calibrated instruments at all times.

There was change of ownership at one of our large irradiators. A new license, 4430-1 was issued for Sterigenics, US, LLC and the previous license, number 2244-1 for Food Technology Services, Inc. was terminated.

Bankruptcy notification was received from RCOA Imaging Services, Inc. License Numbers (all for mobile nuclear medicine) 3110-2, 3110-3, 3110-4, 3110-7, 3110-8 and 3110-9 were subsequently terminated.

Copies are included in our Technical Licensing Procedures and most are also available on our website located at FLHealth.gov/radiation.

RATS 2007-2 and 2007-3 list comments regarding proposed rules. These Rules became effective 12/26/2013. A copy of the final rules and comments addressed are being sent to NRC for review and a copy will be available during the IMPEP.

RATS 2009-1 were comments made on medical rules. The final rule changes that address these comments were effective 12/26/2013. A copy of the final rules and comments addressed are being sent to NRC for review and a copy will be available during the IMPEP.

The above RATS deal with the changes due to the Energy Policy Act which provide NRC the authority to regulate accelerator produced radioactive materials and discrete radium. Florida has always possessed the authority to regulate these materials and has regulated them in the same fashion as any radioactive materials. Therefore substantial portions of these RATS were already addressed in our regulations. In January 2011, Executive order 11-001 halted all rules in process and requires rules to receive review and approval from the Governor's office. We were able to proceed with these rule changes in August 2012 and they became final in December 2013.

RATS 2011-2 only applies to Agreement States with authority to license uranium mills and repeats general licensing requirements in 30.33.

RATS 2012-1

Florida was one of the petitioners to change the compatibility from B to C due to NRC review or Florida rules to comply with RATS 2001-1. The Florida rule text has not changed since the petition.

A letter regarding RATS 2011-2 and 2012-1 was sent to NRC on 01/27/2015.

28. If you have not adopted all amendments within three years from the date of NRC rule promulgation, briefly describe your State's procedures for amending regulations in order to maintain compatibility with the NRC, showing the normal length of time anticipated to complete each step.

RATS 2007-3 and 2009-1 were adopted after the due date.

In January 2011, Executive Order 11-001 halted all rules in process and required rules to receive review and approval from the Governor's office. We were able to proceed with these rule changes in September 2012 and they became final in December 2013. Attached are the current procedures for amending our regulations based on the last rule change. We anticipate that this process takes ~15 months and if legislative ratification is required an additional 6-12 months is needed. The rule process is described in Chapter 120, Florida Statutes. Below is a summary of the process.

SUMMARY:

Rule Development:

The program submits a Notice to Develop Rulemaking to the Department. The Department sends it to the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability (OFARR) in the Governor's Office for review and approval. Once permission is given, the Department publishes a Notice to Develop Rulemaking in the Florida Administrative Register (FAR) for a period of 21 days offering to hold a rule development workshop. If a workshop is requested it is published in the FAR a minimum of seven days prior to the workshop providing the date, time and location of the workshop. The Notice of Proposed Rulemaking must be published within one year from the Notice of Rule Development.

Rule Proposal:

After the workshop (if held) any substantive changes or comments acceptable to the program are incorporated in the proposed regulations. The program drafts proposed regulations which receive Department level review (~1-9 months). The Department sends it to OFARR for review and approval. Once permission is given, the Department publishes a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in FAR for a period of 21 days offering to hold a public hearing about the proposed regulations. If a hearing is requested, it is noticed in the FAR a minimum of seven days prior to the hearing providing date, time and location of the hearing.

Adoption:

Following the 21-day notification period or the hearing (if held) and no substantive changes are requested by the public or Joint Administrative Procedures Committee (JAPC), the program prepares documents for certification of the regulations and documents incorporated by reference. The Department submits these documents to JAPC who has seven days to review/approve. Providing there are no additional comments or changes required by JAPC, regulations are filed with the Florida Department of State. The final regulations must be filed no less than 28 days and no more 90 days of the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking.

Departmental processing procedures in more detail are available. Additional timeframes are outlined in Chapter 120, Florida Statutes for scenarios requiring public hearings and legislative ratification, for example.

I. Basic Inspection Training

The Bureau of Radiation Control's Inspector Training Program is a performance based system that focuses on teaching general inspection skills as a foundation. The general inspection skills are taught through the guidance and accompaniments of inspection managers and seasoned inspection staff. The **"Inspection Guidelines for Field Operations"** training module is a detailed guide to this process.

The Bureau also conducts an in-house **"Applied Radiation Physics"** course and an **"Incident Response"** course for all technical Staff.

There are 3 basic inspection training modules, **"X-ray Training Manual"**, **"Portable Gauge Training"** and **"Diagnostic Nuclear Medicine Training"**. These modules will, in detail, guide the training of an inspector in a Medical and a Non-Medical inspection type. Once these modules are completed by an inspector and inspection audits performed, the inspector is authorized to perform other types of inspections after accompaniment with an experienced inspector and the approval of the inspection manager. There are additional, supplemental training modules such as **"Transportation of RAM"**, and **"Radiopharmaceutical Therapy"**. Additionally, technical staff are encouraged to attend relevant supplemental and refresher training offered by NRC, FEMA, CRCPD, FDA, CDC, DHS, HPS, AAPM, and other organizations. Bureau staff will also participate and train in emergency exercises with other agencies.

Upon completion of the 3 basic inspection training modules or equivalent, inspectors will have a good understanding of the following:

- Use of Field Notes

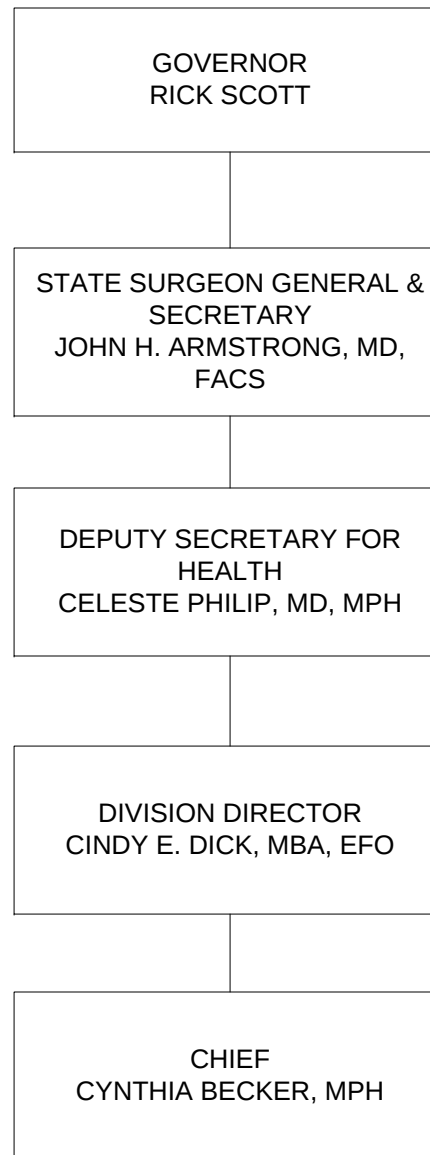

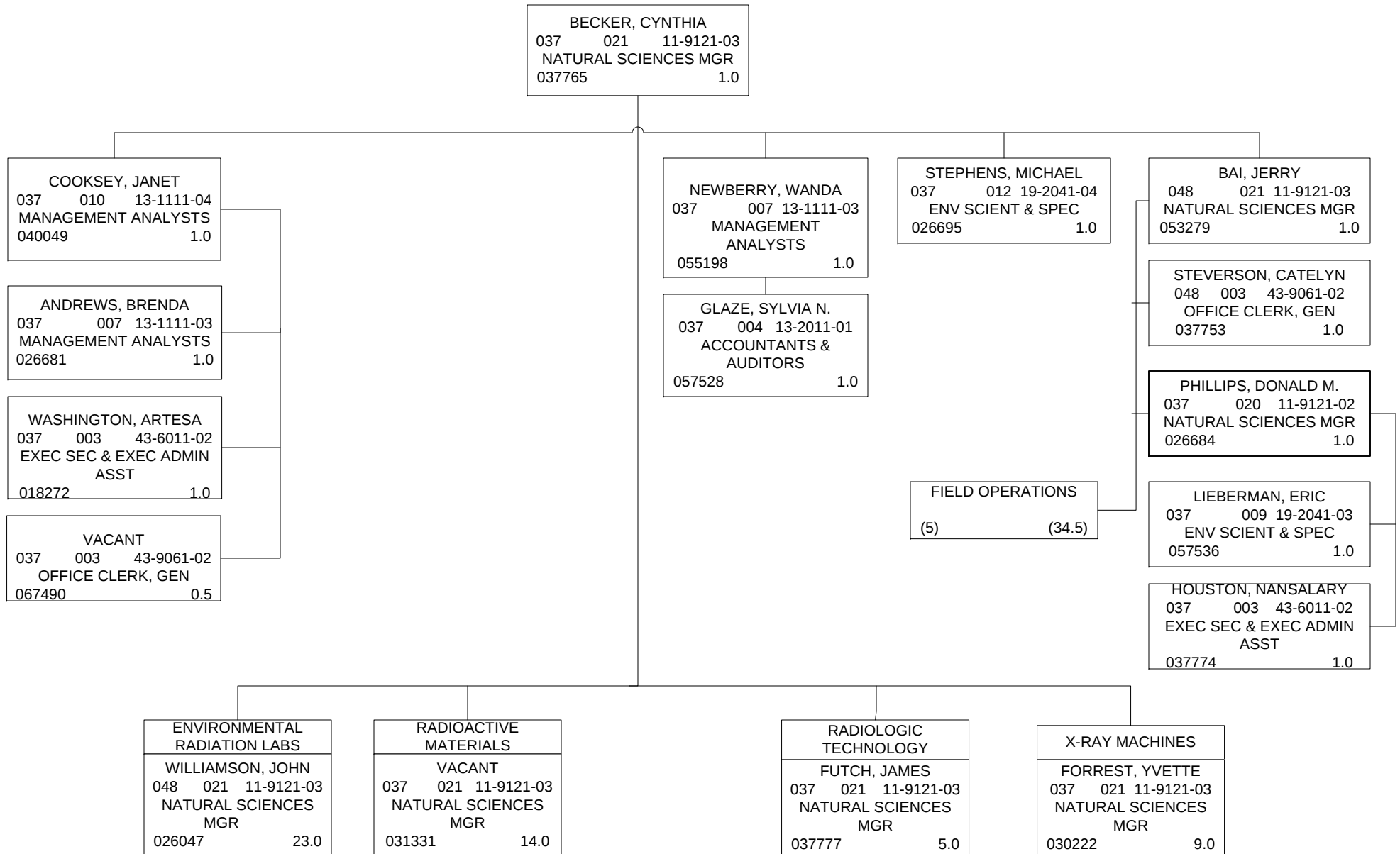
