Dear Mr. Olson,

This letter confirms that American Nuclear Insurers will amend the site descriptions under the captioned policy and certificate to include the area where the Enrico Fermi Unit III is proposed to be built. The amended site description will read as follows:

Location: All of the premises including the land and all buildings and structures of DTE Electric Company's Enrico Fermi Units I, II and III located in Lagoona Beach, Frenchtown Township, Monroe County, Michigan described as follows and as illustrated in the attached diagram:

"Commencing at the intersection of coordinate points N-6000 and E-6000, thence in an easterly direction to point 1, thence in a northerly direction to point 2, thence in a westerly direction to point 3, thence in a straight line to the southeastern point of the Fermi II security fence, thence along the Fermi II security fence in a northerly, westerly, and southerly direction to the southwestern point of the Fermi II security fence, thence in a straight line in a straight line in a southerly direction to point 4, thence in a straight line in an easterly direction to point 5, thence in a southerly direction to point 6, thence in an easterly direction to point 7, thence in a straight line to coordinate point N-6000 and E-6000. Additionally, the site will include the two Fermi II cooling towers, the Fermi II circulating water pump house, the Fermi III cooling tower, and all connecting piping, etc."

The effective date of the amended site descriptions will be concurrent with the date of the NRC's license amendment and amended indemnity agreement.

This commitment to amend the site descriptions to include Enrico Fermi Unit III remains valid thru September 1, 2015. In the event the license amendment and issuance of the amended indemnity agreement occurs after this date, ANI will review the existing circumstances prior to reinstating our commitment to do so.
