NRC Meeting March 13 in Rockville, Md, to Discuss Fukushima Lessons at Facilities Other Than Operating U.S. Nuclear Power Plants

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with the public Friday, March 13, to discuss the agency's ongoing efforts to implement lessons from the March 2011 Fukushima Daiichi nuclear accident.

The [meeting](#) will be from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. in room O8B4 in the NRC's One White Flint building at 11555 Rockville Pike in Rockville, Md. The agenda seeks public comment on the staff's [preliminary assessment](#) of how the agency's lessons-learned effort applies to NRC-regulated sites other than operating nuclear power plants. Facilities covered by the assessment include decommissioning reactors, spent fuel storage sites, industrial irradiators, research and test reactors, and sites that play a role in creating nuclear fuel.

The meeting includes a teleconference and webinar for those unable to attend in person.
