I just read in one of the various meeting announcements that I should let you know that I will be attending next Tuesday's regulatory conference in person, to facilitate my entry into NRC Region 3 HQ. I do plan to be there in person.

Also, in follow up to a voice mail I left earlier today, it is not clear to me that a public comment section will be provided as part of the meeting agenda, such as after the conclusion of NRC's interchange with Entergy. If there is no public comment session planned, I urge that it be added. At a similar regulatory conference with Entergy Palisades at NRC Region 3 HQ three years ago now, a public comment session was a part of the agenda. In fact, there are many precedents I could cite, in NRC interactions with industry, where public comment is part and parcel of the agenda.
