I. SECY-14-0140 – Omaha Public Power District (Fort Calhoun Station, Unit 1), Petition to Intervene and Request for Adjudicatory Hearing by Sierra Club (Apr. 23, 2014)

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to a hearing request by the Sierra Club on license amendments it claims are, or will be, required for the Fort Calhoun Station. The Memorandum and Order denies the hearing request and refers the matters raised in it to the Executive Director for Operations for consideration under 10 C.F.R. § 2.206.

II. SECY-14-0115 - Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. (Indian Point Nuclear Generating Units 2 and 3), Petitions for Review of LBP-13-13 and Related Decisions (Appeals of Board Decisions Related to Contentions NYS-8 and CW-EC-3A)

The Commission¹ approved a Memorandum and Order addressing petitions for review of two contentions resolved in LBP-13-13: New York State's Contention NYS-8 (aging management review of transformers) and Hudson River Sloop Clearwater's Contention CW-EC-3A (environmental justice). The Memorandum and Order reverses the Board's decision with respect to Contention NYS-8, and affirms in part, and reverses in part, its decision with respect to Contention CW-EC-3A.
