Members of the public desiring to provide oral statements and/or written comments should notify the Designated Federal Official (DFO), Quynh Nguyen (Telephone 301-415-5844 or Email: Quynh.Nguyen@nrc.gov) five days prior to the meeting, if possible, so that arrangements can be made. Thirty-five hard copies of each presentation or handout should be provided to the DFO thirty minutes before the meeting. In addition, one electronic copy of each presentation should be emailed to the DFO one day before the meeting. If an electronic copy cannot be provided within this timeframe, presenters should provide the DFO with a CD

containing each presentation at least thirty minutes before the meeting. Electronic recordings

will be permitted only during those portions of the meeting that are open to the public. Detailed

procedures for the conduct of and participation in ACRS meetings were published in the Federal

Register on October 13, 2014 (79 FR 59307-59308).

Information regarding changes to the agenda, whether the meeting has been canceled

or rescheduled, and the time allotted to present oral statements can be obtained by contacting

the identified DFO. Moreover, in view of the possibility that the schedule for ACRS meetings

may be adjusted by the Chairman as necessary to facilitate the conduct of the meeting, persons

planning to attend should check with the DFO if such rescheduling would result in a major

inconvenience.
