Dear Mr. Williams:

I am responding to your letter dated January 12, 2015, which requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approve a new Truck Route designated as No. 248 for transporting spent nuclear fuel from the North Anna Nuclear Generation Station, Mineral, Virginia to Idaho National Laboratory, Scoville, Idaho.

The NRC has reviewed your application and concluded that the information satisfies the requirements of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 73.37. This letter constitutes approval of Truck Route No. 248 which will expire January 11, 2020. The NRC expects your periodic review and update of the emergency phone numbers associated with this route. Changes to emergency contact numbers do not qualify as a route deviation or change.
