On December 18, 2014 the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) released Draft NUREG-2126 for public review and comment. Due to the number of other issues the agency is working on and the fact Utah has the only operating conventional mill in the country, the Utah Division of Radiation Control (UDRC) requests an extension of the comment period.

In addition to the conventional mill, Utah has a number of uranium facilities in Utah that this draft NUREG will impact. The DRC intends to submit comments on the draft NUREG but more time is needed to analyze the guidance document.
