Dear Mr. Berkley:

This is in reference to your letter dated January 27, 2015 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 47-09772-02. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Your application should have been signed by a management representative rather than you. Please submit a letter signed by a management representative indicating that management has reviewed the application and concurs in the statements and representations contained therein. Note also that a management representative should sign all future correspondence that requests a change in your license.
2. In support of your request to authorize Dr. Guan for use of the Cesium-137 calibrator for survey meter checks, please provide one of the following, as applicable:
 - a. Previous license number (if issued by NRC) or a copy of the license (if issued by an Agreement State) on which Dr. Guan was specifically named as an authorized user for the uses requested; or
 - b. Documentation and description of the training and experience demonstrating that the proposed user is qualified by training and experience for the use requested.
