Ms Snyder,

I have been informed by an investigative source that up to six Davy Crockett nuclear weapons were actually detonated at Pohakuloa in the late 1950s-early 1960s, not simply Davy Crockett DU spotting rounds used in training there.

Please attempt to confirm or deny this report by the March 24, 2015 meeting date. Please note that for years the Army denied that DU was ever used at Pohakuloa. It was only after our organization first recorded above background radiation spikes at Mauna Kea Park on May 29, 2007 that the Army officially confirmed in Aug. 2007 that DU weapons had been used at Pohakuloa.
