Purpose

In accordance with the Reference, American Centrifuge Operating, LLC (ACO) hereby submits the system inventory for the following cyber security plans to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC):

- SP-3605-0011, *American Centrifuge Classified Administrative Network Information System Security Plan (ISSP)*, Revision 0
- SP-3605-0013, *American Centrifuge Distributed Control System Information System Security Plan (ISSP)*, Revision 0

Background

On January 28, 2015 (Reference), the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed the review of ACO's proposed cyber security plans. Based on the NRC staff's review, ACO was authorized to operate the networks described in ISSPs SP-3605-0011 and SP-3605-0013 for the processing of information up to, and including, Secret Restricted Data with the stipulation that the system inventory of these networks must include the name and versions of the operating systems. This information was requested to be submitted to the NRC within one month from the date of the Reference.


Action
