On February 27, 2015, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security baseline inspection at your Surry Power Station. The inspection covered one or more of the key attributes of the security cornerstone of the NRC's Reactor Oversight Process. Portions of the inspection associated with Access Authorization, Protection of Safeguards Information, and Fitness-for-Duty were completed at the Dominion Corporate Office on January 9, 2015. The enclosed inspection report (IR) documents the inspection results that were discussed on March 2, 2015, with Mr. Nelson Martin and other members of your staff.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations, and with the conditions of your license. The inspectors reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel.

No findings were identified during this inspection.
