Good Morning, everyone. I spoke with the NY SLO with respect to the pending legislation in NY State requiring NYSEMO to conduct a review and develop individual site specific disaster plans for each nuclear power plant. The review is to include the feasibility of evacuating areas within 50 miles of a power plant. The Executive Law was introduced by Senator Lavelle and Assemblyman Thiele who represent Suffolk County. Apparently, it was first introduced in 2001 and every two years since, following a Legislation Election. However, the Legislation has never put in on the Docket for discussion and NYSEMO has never been directed by the Governor's Office to conduct such a review. NYSEMO believes the same will occur this time, particularly in a time the State is busy handling a very serious budget crises. NY will keep us informed should they believe that the Executive Law will be seriously considered.
