SUBJECT: MODIFICATION OF BOARD RECOGNITION

Dear Dr. Teng:

I am writing in response to your letters dated December 19, 2014, and March 18, 2015, seeking additional recognition by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of the American Osteopathic Board of Radiology (AOBR) certification process for the Diagnostic Radiology specialty under 10 CFR 35.394(a).

The NRC staff reviewed AOBR's certification process for the Diagnostic Radiology specialty and determined, based on the above-cited letters, that it meets the applicable requirements in 10 CFR 35.394(a) for NRC recognition for certificates with the marking "AU Eligible" issued beginning May 17, 2015. Accordingly, AOBR's certification process for the Diagnostic Radiology specialty will be listed on NRC's Web site for Part 35 matters at <http://www.nrc.gov/materials/miau/med-use-toolkit.html> with an effective date of recognition of May 17, 2015 for 35.394(a). A link to an example of the certificate issued to the diplomates will be provided on the Web site.

In previous correspondence dated June 28, 2006, the NRC recognized the AOBR's certification process for the Diagnostic Radiology specialty under 10 CFR 35.290(a) and 35.392(a) with an effective date of July 1, 2000. A link to an example of the certificates issued to the diplomates between July 1, 2000 and July 1, 2012 will also be provided on the NRC's web site.

Please notify the NRC, via letter, 6 months in advance of AOBR plans for becoming inactive or disbanding, plans to inactivate or disband the certification program, as well as of changes to the boards name, certification processes, or certification documents that would affect the recognition of AOBR's Diagnostic Radiology certification process under the requirements of 10 CFR 35.290(a), 10 CFR 35.392(a), and 10 CFR 35.394(a).
