Dear Ms. Ullrich:

Enclosed; please find the required information on December 30, 2014, regarding our NRC license renewal:

1. Item 10.8 - we will develop, maintain, and implement operating and emergency procedures that meet the criteria for fixed gauges in NUREG-1556, Volume 4, Section 8.10.6 and Appendix L.
2. Item 10.9 – we will follow Section 8.10.8 of NUREG-1556, Volume 4, which stated that *“The gauge manufacturer, distributor or other person authorized by NRC or an Agreement State will perform non-routine operations such as installation, initial radiation survey, repair, and maintenance of components related to the radiological safety of the gauge, gauge relocation, replacement, and disposal of sealed sources, alignment, or removal of a gauge from service”*.
3. Regarding the “radiation Safety Program”, we will continue with the one established on 2004. Please disregard the information in the following:
  - a. Section 4.1 and Section 4.2 – we meet the exception to posting requirements described in 10 CFR 20.1903(c).
  - b. Section 4.4, 4.5, 4.6 and 4.7



- c. Section 5 – we will maintain the following surveys; required after installation or repair, and leak-tests at 6 months intervals, as described in our operating procedures.
- d. Section 7
- e. Section 8.1
- f. Section 9 –we will follow Section 8.7 of NUREG-1556, Volume 4, and are committing to train authorized users as described in Section 8.7 and Appendix G, "Criteria for Acceptable Training of Authorized Users and Radiation Safety Officers". We also will include the following topics: lock-out/tag-out procedures, operating procedures, emergency procedures, and maintenance activities.
