PerkinElmer (PKI) is requesting an Amendment to the Exempt Distribution License #20-00320-14E concerning the Ba-133 1.0 microcurie exempt source distributed in liquid scintillation counter device model no. 3180XX series. Specifically (i.e. Item 9B):

- Model No. 3180XX Series is being changed to Model No. A6220XX Series.


None of the substantive statements made in the original amendment communication letter related to this device dated June 3, 2013, or any subsequent communications other than model number have been changed. Physical changes to the device involves software updates and modifications, and does not change in any way the radioactive material content, quantity, or source design, drive or delivery mechanism.

Manufacture under the original model number may continue for some limited time after the new model production starts. Both model numbers will be distributed initially.

The radioactive material identified above is possessed under State of Massachusetts License No. 56-0683. This license is also being amended to clarify the change in model numbers.
