## General Comment

1. Two top Entergy officials names are misspelled in that document - Michael Twomey (not Toomey) and Jay Thayer (not Faer)
2. I'd like to reiterate my two recommendations -
  - a. The cast storage needs be consider and prepared as if it were going to be in Vermont permanently as there is no designated place for it to be taken, and not consider it a temporary placement as it is too great a risk for the tri-state and the enviornment.
  - b. The decomissioning of Vermont Yankee needs to commence as soon as radiologically feasible, and not "wait for the money to grow", particularly since there are known leaks of various toxic and radiologically active materials from the grounds and buildings which need to be cleaned up now. The decomissioning fund has sufficient funds to get started, and should be used for this purpose now. Site restoration and on-site storage costs are not to come out of the decommissioning fund and are to be paid separately by the company.
3. The comment period needs to be extended from today (as we just received access to the transmission Friday past, and the deadline is today March 23, 2015).
