Attached to this memorandum is the official transcript for the Category 3 public meeting held by staff in the Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research (RES) to solicit technical information from a panel of independent outside experts concerning degradation of concrete in dry cask storage systems. The meeting was conducted on Tuesday, February 24 and Wednesday, February 25, 2015 at the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) headquarters in Rockville, MD. The meeting notice was issued on February 2, 2015 (ML15034A010) and the meeting summary was issued on March 3, 2015 (ML15062A054).

The participants in the public meeting included NRC staff from RES and the Office of Nuclear Materials Safety and Safeguards, NRC contractors from Southwest Research Institute (SWRI), the expert panel members subcontracted to NRC through SWRI, industry stakeholders, and members of the public. NRC staff made no commitments concerning ongoing or future regulatory actions. Opinions expressed by individual staff or contractors during the meeting do not necessarily represent those of NRC.
