SUBJECT: STAFF REQUIREMENTS – SECY-15-0029 – REPORT TO
CONGRESS ON ABNORMAL OCCURRENCES:
FISCAL YEAR 2014

The Commission has approved the proposed FY 2014 Report to Congress on Abnormal Occurrences (AOs), subject to the attached comments and changes.

Prior to the next report to Congress, the staff should identify an estimate of the number of byproduct medical procedures, both tests and treatments, performed in the United States to put into context the number of AOs reported in future reports to Congress on AOs.

The staff should continue to work with the Agreement States to improve the timeliness, consistency, and completeness of the information that is reported.

Changes to the FY 2014 Report to Congress on Abnormal Occurrences

1. Page iii, 3rd ¶, last sentence, revise to read: "...in comparison to the high number millions of medical procedures..."
2. Page viii, 2nd full ¶, add a comma after the *Federal Register* citations in lines 2 and 4.
3. Page 1, indent the 2nd line of the heading for AS14-01.
4. Page 1, AS14-01, 3rd ¶, line 4, revise to read: "...requested a re-test, which..."
5. Page 1, AS14-01, 4th ¶, line 4, revise to read: "...occured occurred;..."
6. Page 5, indent the 2nd line of the heading for NRC14-01.
7. Page B-2, "Background" section, line 6, revise to read: "...with regards to..."
8. Page B-2, "Update..." section, line 2, revise to read: "...Accession No. ML102020551), which..."
