**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF NAC INTERNATIONAL REQUEST FOR WITHHOLDING  
INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE – RENEWAL OF THE  
CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE FOR THE MODEL NO. NAC-LWT**

By letters dated November 25, 2014, January 23, 2015, January 29, 2015, February 4, 2015, February 13, 2015, and March 4, 2015, you submitted affidavits dated November 25, 2014, January 23, 2015, January 29, 2015, February 4, 2015, February 13, 2015, and March 4, 2015, respectively requesting that the information contained in the following documents be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 2, Section 2.390:

1. Request for Timely Renewal of U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 9225 and for Approval to Use Hardware Used to Transport NRU/NRX Fuel that has Nondestructive Examination Related Non-Conformances. November 25, 2014.
2. Final Safety Analysis Report for the Model No. NAC-LWT, Revision 42. November 25, 2014.
3. Submission of Information in Support of Request for Approval for LWT Non-Conforming Hardware. January 23, 2015.
4. Final Safety Analysis Report for the Model No. NAC-LWT, Revision 43. January 29, 2015.
5. Submission of Information in Support of Request for Approval for LWT Nonconforming Hardware. February 4, 2015.
6. Submission of Information in Support of Request for Approval for LWT Non-Conforming Hardware. February 13, 2015.
7. Submission of Information in Support of Request for Approval for LWT Non-Conforming Hardware. March 5, 2015.

A non-proprietary copy of Revision 42 and 43 of the application were placed in the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Public Document Room and added to the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Public Electronic Reading Room.

The affidavits state that the submitted information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure for the following reasons:

- Information that discloses a process, method, or apparatus, including supporting data and analyses, where prevention of its use by competitors of NAC, without license from NAC, constitutes a competitive economic advantage over other companies.
- Information that, if used by a competitor, would reduce their expenditure of resources or improve their competitive position in the design, manufacture, shipment, installation, assurance of quality or licensing of a similar product.
- Information that reveals aspects of past, present, or future NAC customer-funded development plans and programs of potential commercial value to NAC.

We have reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 and, on the basis of your statements, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Therefore, the version(s) of the submitted information marked as proprietary will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, you should promptly notify the NRC. You also should understand that the NRC may have cause to review this determination in the future, for example, if the scope of a Freedom of Information Act request includes your information. In all review situations, if the NRC makes a determination adverse to the above, you will be notified of the date of public disclosure, in advance which will be a reasonable time thereafter.
