This is in regard to your renewal application dated March 4, 2015. The application was signed by the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). NRC policy requires that all correspondence related to a license be signed by a member of the licensee's senior management, and not by the RSO or a consultant. Therefore, we cannot accept the application and you must submit application signed by the company's senior manager with his/her title, and dated. Also please include the following information:

1. You are located in an Agreement State and it is not necessary to include your entire inventory of gauges in your NRC license. Please estimate the total number of gauges that you expect to use in NRC jurisdiction at any one time. Most of the Agreement State licenses estimate no more than 5 gauges that they expect to use in NRC jurisdiction;
2. Provide model numbers (not serial numbers) of the gauges that you may use in NRC jurisdiction;
3. Complete NRC Form 313 (signed as described above and dated), and include a completed Appendix B.
