Dear Administrative Judges:

In accordance with the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's "Order (Requesting Information from All Participants)" of March 31, 2015, the NRC Staff wishes to provide the following information:

1. At this time, the Staff expects to be available for evidentiary hearings on all dates during the weeks of November 16 and 30, 2015, except Monday, November 30, 2015. On that date, one of the Staff's witnesses and one of its attorneys expect to be traveling home from the Thanksgiving holiday weekend. In addition, because travel to Tarrytown on Sunday, November 29 is likely to be very difficult due to the large number of Thanksgiving holiday travelers, the Staff requests that any hearings held during the week of November 30 commence no earlier than Tuesday, December 1, 2015.
2. The Staff expects to have five people at its table during the evidentiary hearings.


