The Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe (CRST) is in disagreement to the proposed "field study" submitted in the letter dated October 31, 2012 for the Crow Butte, North Trend, Marsland, and Three Crow In-Situ Uranium Recovery Projects.

CRST and other Lakota Tribes made comments and recommendations during previous consultation and site visit for a Traditional Cultural Property (TCP) Survey due to the high density of features at several locations. There was no communication with Tribes for what is now proposed by NRCs field study but yet you want Tribes to either submit a response of interest or "NRC will deem you have decided not to participate". It is not the NRC to make such a statement for Tribes.

The dates of which the field study was to be conducted was not discussed with Tribes. When were deadlines applied in the Section 106 process?

Section 106 is the responsibility of the federal agency, not the applicant.

You will receive other letters of opposition to the resent letter from Tribes and all of the comments and recommendations need to be reviewed and brought back to the table for consultation.

All communication between NRC and CRST with regards to this and other projects will be shared with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) as we feel you have not kept the best interest of Tribes in your meetings with the applicants.
