NRC Schedules Public Meeting April 21 in Piketon to Discuss Lead Cascade Facility

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff has scheduled a public meeting in Piketon, Ohio, on April 21 to discuss results of the agency's most recent review of American Centrifuge Operating's Lead Cascade facility.

The meeting is scheduled to begin at 6 p.m. at the Ohio State University Endeavor Center, 1864 Shyville Road in Piketon. The NRC staff will discuss with company officials the results of the agency's review of safety performance at the plant from Jan. 1, 2013, to Dec. 31, 2014. The discussion will include the areas of safety operations, radiological controls, facility support and licensing.

In its review, the NRC found no areas needing improvement and concluded that the facility continued to conduct its activities safely and securely. Because of that performance and the limited scope of operations, the NRC plans to continue conducting a more limited inspection program at the facility.

The meeting will be open to the public and media, and NRC officials will be available to answer questions after the business portion of the meeting.
