SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 49-35126-01

By letter dated February 17, 2015, you informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that PMPC wished to terminate NRC radioactive materials license number 49-35126-01. The NRC Forms 314 dated February 17, 2015 stated that all radioactive materials had been disposed by transfer to a licensed entity.

The supporting documentation to the NRC Form 314 provided copies of the most recent leak test results. The leak test results showed that there was no evidence of leakage of radioactive material from the sealed sources. Based on the documentation submitted and a review of your historical file, the staff concluded that the all four Radium-226 gauges were transferred to a licensed entity. However, the Cesium-137 and Americium-241/Be portable gauges remain in the same physical location and are authorized under the Engineering Associates NRC license number 49-23182-01. Therefore the location of use is NOT being released for unrestricted use because licensable activities will continue under the Engineering Associates NRC license from the location of use on the license.

Please find enclosed Amendment No. 01 to License No. 49-35126-01 authorizing your license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(ii).
