

Instructions for Remote Participation in the Public Meeting to Comments Received on Three Draft Regulatory Guides on April 29-30, 2015.

The following information is provided to explain the process for remote participation in this public meeting.

For this meeting, the slides will be shown through GoToMeeting and the audio will be available through a conference call-in line. There is a separate link for Wednesday and Thursday's webinar, but the bridge line will be the same.

Webinar Registration:

You should register for the webinar before the meeting using the links below:

After registering, you will receive an email with a unique link for you to use to log on the day of the meeting.

On the day of the meeting, you will click on the link you received by email. This will allow you to see all the slides being presented in real time. When you use this link, we will see the name registered for this link appear on the virtual attendees list and any questions asked once logged on will be associated with this name, that's why the email indicates that the link shouldn't be shared with others. Again, keep in mind that there is a separate link for each day.

Bridge Line:

You can hear the audio from the meeting by calling into a bridge line. There is a toll free call-in number for those calling from within the US, and a toll number for those calling from outside the US. The call in number will be the same for both days for toll-free callers; however the toll number will be different each day. The numbers are:

Toll-Free Number (for calls placed from within the US): 888-790-3263

Toll Number (for calls placed outside the US): 1-630-395-0371 on 4/29; 1-415-228-4999 on 4/30

In both cases, the pass code will be 1233623.

This line will be run by an operator who will work with callers who would like to make a comment or actively join discussions. This will only occur at designated points throughout the agenda.
